

## **SHANNON COUNTY MINUTES OF APRIL 19, 2012**

The Shannon Board of County Commissioners met via teleconference on April 19, 2012. Present: Wendell Yellow Bull, Lyla Hutchison, Deloris Hagman, Bryan Kehn, Auditor Sue Ganje and Director of Equalization Terri Halls. Absent: Eugenio White Hawk.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The agenda was reviewed for conflicts; none were identified.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hagman, to convene as the Board of Equalization. With no further discussion and all voting yes on a roll call vote, the motion carried and the Board convened as the Board of Equalization.

No appeals were filed on classification or value. The Board reviewed the Exempt list.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hagman, to deny the requests from Makasan Presbyterian Church and Wakanyeja Pawicayapi, Inc. as no forms were filed, unless their forms are received by May 3, 2012. With no further discussion and all voting yes on a roll call vote, the motion carried.

Eugenio White Hawk joined the teleconference at 10:11 a.m.

Motion by Hagman, seconded by White Hawk, to table the exempt status of Wounded Knee District Community Development Corp. until further information is submitted to the Director of Equalization by May 3, 2012. With no further discussion and all voting yes on a roll call vote, the motion carried and the matter tabled.

Motion by Hagman, seconded by Hutchison, to adjourn as the Board of Equalization and reconvene as the Board of Commissioners. With no further discussion and all voting yes on a roll call vote, the motion carried.

Polling locations were discussed including the possibility of using the Singing Horse Trading Post, located seven miles north of Manderson, for a Rockyford polling location. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hagman, to approve the Resolution as follows, establishing polling locations. With no further discussion and all voting yes on a roll call vote, the motion carried.
