Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk, to approve the minutes of the March 1, 2013 meeting. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Kehn, seconded by White Hawk, to accept and place on file Hopkins' monthly report and to approve travel for Hopkins to attend training in Rapid City on April 30 – May 1, 2013. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Diaz joined the meeting at 12:23 PM. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk, to approve and place on file the 2012 Soil Conservation Report. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Kehn, seconded by Hutchison, to approve and place on file the 2012 Election Report of Lakota Coordinator Jean Belt, commending her and Steven Slow Bear for their work. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Lynx Bettelyoun updated the Board on roadwork and discussed the need for a five to seven year capital outlay plan. Cost accounting reports for the department were reviewed and private road contracts were presented. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk, to approve two private road contracts, one with Charles Divan and one with Juanita Swift Water, at a cost of \$118.00 each, which is paid. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Fuel quotes were presented.

Motion by Kehn, seconded by White Hawk, to approve Westco's bid of \$3.34 per gallon for unleaded and \$3.49 per gallon for diesel as the only bids. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Sheriff Jim Daggett presented his monthly report and discussed a meeting with tribal officials, including the Oglala Sioux Tribe Attorney General. Daggett requested approval to appoint a special Deputy Sherriff to aid in transports and offer a faster response time as the deputy would reside in Shannon County. Motion by White Hawk, seconded by Kehn, to appoint Robert 'Joe' Herman as a Special Deputy Sheriff on an unpaid, volunteer basis, using a vehicle provided by OST Dept. of Public Safety that will be maintained and insured by the county. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by White Hawk, seconded by Hutchison, to approve travel for Daggett to attend training in Deadwood on April 30 – May 2, 2012. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

FBI Supervisory Agent Bob Perry met with the Board to present a Certificate of Appreciation to Sheriff Daggett for his county investigation and pursuit of a multi-state case. Motion by Kehn, seconded by White Hawk, to commend Sheriff Daggett for his work and express their appreciation of his efforts. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Keith Ferguson, Pine Ridge Extension, met with the Board to discuss realignment of the SDSU Extension programs. Although Shannon County is in a regional district, there is still an office located outside Kyle to serve residents. Ferguson described several programs of the Extension office and expressed the hope that funding might be available from the county in the future. Increasing youth participation was discussed, including 4-H programs and possibilities for a horse show or rodeo activity.

Jim Bingham, Mental Health Chairman, met with the Board to explain the mental health committal process. Current billings were discussed and the possible need for an Attorney General's opinion on the responsible party for payment.

Equalization Director Susie Hayes advised the Board of appeals received and what has been stipulated. Motion by Kehn, seconded by Diaz, to set April 26, 2013 at 12:00 noon as the time for a meeting as the Board of Equalization and to follow up on mental health billings. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk, to approve the bills as presented with the exception of the tribal hold portion of the mental health evaluations in the amount of \$2,573.54, which will be forwarded to State's Attorney Jim Sword for review. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.
