Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Diaz, to accept Hopkins' monthly report and place it on file. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk to accept the March 2013 General Fund Surplus Analysis as presented. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk, to accept the 2012 Annual Report and place it on the next agenda for discussion when Auditor Sue Ganje is present. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by White Hawk, seconded by Diaz, to approve a lodging and mileage travel request for Coroner Audrey Martinez and a Deputy Coroner to attend training in Pierre on May 9-10, 2013. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Kehn, seconded by Hutchison, to appoint Yellow Bull as the Board representative on a Veterans and Military Affairs Committee established by the South Dakota Association of County Commissioners. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by White Hawk, seconded by Kehn, to approve a travel request for VSO Hopkins to attend training in Sturgis on May 21, 2013 at a cost of \$254.00. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Lynx Bettelyoun provided the Board with an update on STP funds available, recommending along with Hutchison that the county accumulates funding until there is enough to complete a project. Discussion was held on identifying roads that could potentially be addressed with the funds.

Bettelyoun informed the Board that the individual for whom he was seeking hire approval is no longer interested in the position. An alternate candidate was discussed. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Kehn, to authorize Bettelyoun to offer the position to his alternate candidate, adding formal approval to the next agenda. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

An updated agreement for road maintenance with the Town of Batesland was presented. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by White Hawk, to approve an agreement with the Town of Batesland for road maintenance for a period of four years, authorizing the Chairman to sign. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Diaz, to approve Westco's bid of \$3.27 per gallon for unleaded and \$3.335 per gallon for diesel as the low bids. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Susie Hayes, Director of Equalization, presented a travel request. Motion by Kehn, seconded by White Hawk, to approve travel for Jacki Miller, Equalization, to attend a conference in Pierre on May 28-31, 2013, at a cost of \$593.00. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Sheriff Jim Daggett presented his monthly report and discussed an agreement with the Oglala Sioux Tribe. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Diaz, to approve and authorize the Vice-Chairman to sign a two-year Joint Powers agreement with the Oglala Sioux Tribe allowing for the use of a tribal vehicle by a Deputy Sheriff, which will be insured and maintained by the county, to be evaluated at the end of the agreement. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

State's Attorney Jim Sword met with the Board to discuss costs associated with mental health committals. Sword indicated he has a meeting set with the Attorney General for the Tribe on May 16, 2013, to discuss the committal process and other issues, suggesting a Joint Powers agreement might be established which would clarify responsibilities for the Tribe and the county. Sword recommended deferring payment on bills associated with committals at the current time, until a follow-up discussion at the next commission meeting. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Diaz, to approve the bills as presented with the exception of bills for Audra Malcomb, the Pennington County State's Attorney and an ambulance transfer, which will be reviewed at the next meeting. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.
