Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Whirlwind Horse to set July 2016 meeting to July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hutchison to approve appointment of all commission members, the Sheriff and the State's Attorney as members of the LEPC Committee, and further report members to the State.

Board received disinterment permit from the South Dakota Department of Health.

The Board met with the Treasurer's office to present a certificate of appreciation for the hard work the Treasurer's office provided regarding tax certificate and deed work in Oglala Lakota County.

Lynx Bettelyoun, Highway Superintendant gave an update on current road maintenance projects; graveling and gravel mining. Bettelyoun requested approval to hire part time summer help for weed spraying.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hutchison to approve hire of Kelli Ferguson for part time seasonal help \$14.00 per hour effective June 13, 2016.

Bettelyoun advised that after research he recommended no change to load limits and leaving the load weight limit at 90,000 pounds. Bettelyoun also spoke on the use of STP funds to regravell County roads. He presented a list of county roads and suggested that 4 inches be put

each road. Bettelyoun requested that the county start projects this year. A five year plan was discussed with priority on which roads would receive gravel first.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Whirlwind Horse to approve setting a date to accept sealed bids for crushing gravel and trucking it to the roads.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hopkins to approve a fuel transfer of \$23.82 from Sheriff's Department to Highway Department for the period of 4-17-16 thru 6-10-16.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hopkins to approve private road work for Ann Conroy in the amount \$73.00 for road grading.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hopkins to approve Westco's fuel bid as the low and only bid for 300 gallons of unleaded at \$2.089 per gallon and 1,700 gallons of #2 red diesel at \$1.769.

The Board reviewed the 2017 budget request for the Highway Department.

Discussion was held on the purchase of a portable scale with options to rent the scale to Oglala Sioux Tribe. Bettelyoun and Sheriff Conroy will look in to cost on purchase of a scale.

Sheriff Rex Conroy met with the Board to report on department Activities in May, 2016. Conroy's report included the search for the 3 missing tribal members. Oglala Lakota Deputy Joe Herman assisted in setting up the command center for the search after the Oglala Sioux Tribe President declared state of emergency and additional resources became available. Other monthly activities were reported.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Whirlwind Horse to approve surplus as junk an expired ballistic vest, a nylon duty belt, a broken CPU, a computer monitor and a broken keyboard and excluding holsters from surplus.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hopkins to approve personnel policy for Oglala Lakota County Employees. A discussion on verbage followed for part time and full-time and seasonal employees. Motion by Hopkins, seconded by Hutchison to table discussion to allow the implementation of discussed verbage for employee type.

Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hopkins to approve travel for Tatewin Means for travel to Deadwood on May 4 & 5 for the National Conference.

Sue Ganje, County Auditor presented the Election budget and the Auditor's budget. The Board reviewed the Emergency Management budget.

Terri Halls, Election Supervisor met with the Board to assist with the election canvass. Motion by Whirlwind Horse, seconded by Hopkins to approve the official canvass of the 2016 Primary Election for Oglala Lakota County.
