The Oglala Lakota Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on August 5, 2016 in the lower level meeting room of Fall River County Courthouse. Present: Wendell Yellow Bull, Lyla Hutchison, Art Hopkins and Sue Ganje, County Auditor. Anna Takes The Shield and Arlin Whirlwind Horse were absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given and the meeting called to order at 1:15 pm. The agenda was reviewed for conflicts; none were indicated. ALL MOTIONS RECORDED IN THESE MINUTES WERE PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hopkins to approve Veterans Service Report for July 2016 and place on file.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hopkins to set the supplemental budget and transfer hearing for September 2, 2016 at 2pm.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hopkins to approve travel to the SDACO Convention on September 12 and 13, 2016 for Wendell Yellow Bull, Art Hopkins, Sue Ganje, Auditor, Melody Engebretson, Register of Deeds, Kelli Rhoe, Treasurer, Jenna Stokesberry, Welfare.

Lynx Bettelyoun, Highway Supervisor, gave an update on the work with Brosz Engineering for the Kyle Road Project, the Porcupine Road for gravel and the Front-end Loader being almost done.

Bettelyoun requested approval for a new hire to live at highway trailer as funds allow noting that an employee on County property adds security. Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hopkins to allow Matthew Thunder Hawk to reside in Highway shop to temporarily with a signed agreement prepared by the Deputy State's Attorney.

Hopkins questioned the time frame for the Road Construction. Bettelyoun informed that the plans for Kyle Road were to finish this year and for Gordon to be started next year. Bettelyoun also informed the Board that the ditch mowing in Kyle will start next week.

Bettelyoun presented the following fuel bids: 400 Gallons Unleaded/1700 Gallons #2 Dyed Diesel

Westco-\$1.949per gal/\$1.719 per gal Pine Ridge Oil- no bid Nelson's- No Bid

Motion by Hopkins, seconded by Hutchison to approve the fuel bid from Westco as the low and only bid at \$1,949 per gallon for 400 gallons of unleaded fuel and \$1.719 per gallon for 1,700 gallons of #2 dyed diesel fuel.

Motion by Hopkins, seconded by Hutchison to approve fuel transfers from the Highway Department in the amount of \$115.55 to the Sheriff's department from July 8 to August 4, 2016.

Motion by Hopkins, seconded by Hutchison to approve private road work in the amount of \$146.00 for the Oglala Lakota School.

At 1:30 pm, as advertised, the bids for the Kyle Road Crushing and Gravel Hauling Project were opened. Ross Eberle of Brosz Engineering was present. Bids were as follows;

Byrne Trucking, 29916 Robbin Road, Martin SD - \$260,275.00

Western Construction, PO Box 771, Rapid City, SD -\$264,736.72

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Hopkins to approve the sealed bid received from Troy Bryne Construction for 14,156 tons of gravel in the amount \$260,275.00 as the low bid, contingent on engineering approval and application completeness.

Sheriff Conroy presented his monthly report. Conroy requested 2 tasers for the sheriff and deputy. The Sheriff is also seeking grant funding for other equipment. Conroy also spoke on the need for bullet resistant vests. Jessie True Blood, Director of School Security is voicing security concerns with in the school to Conroy. Conroy would like to appoint True Blood as a deputy. The Board would like to see Law Enforcement certifications and training before appointment as a volunteer. This issue will be put on the agenda for consideration at the next meeting.

Conroy also addressed the Board regarding his request for \$500 to pay Joe Herman for his services for which there was no objection.

There were questions on the current autopsy bill for the County. Hopkins questioned if there is a way that the Bureau of Indian Affairs or the Oglala Sioux Tribe should share in the cost of coroner expenses.

Susie Simkins, Director of Equalization met with the Board to present an update on Oglala Sioux Tribal deeded lands tax exempt statuses. Simkins advised the Board that she is working with Denise Mesteth of the Oglala Sioux Tribal land office. Simkins also questioned the properties that the tribe has acquired that were previously church properties. There are three properties that will be considered for add-ons in the tax exempt process. Simkins informed the County Commissionners that the OHE has agreed with the County on the Wings As Eagles tax exempt status.

The Board reviewed Budget requests for the 2017 year.
