Highway Superintendent Lynx Bettelyoun presented the Board with updates including a report on a rural water pipeline and right-of-way easements.

Kehn entered the meeting at 12:31 PM.

The 2014 Highway Department budget was discussed.

Diaz joined the meeting at 12:37 PM.

Sheriff Jim Daggett presented his monthly report and updated the Board on the sheriff's vehicle, which was totaled in an accident in July. A settlement from the responsible party's insurer is forthcoming. Discussion was held on obtaining a loan for a replacement vehicle. Motion by Kehn, seconded by Hutchison, to approve a loan at 1st Interstate Bank to purchase a 2009 Chevy Tahoe for use as a sheriff's vehicle. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Pine Ridge Extension Agent Keith Ferguson provided the Board with a report on office activities.

Melody Engebretson, Register of Deeds, met with the Board to discuss the 2014 budget.

Frank Maynard, Emergency Management, discussed the need to appoint an LEPC board. Motion by Kehn, seconded by White Hawk, to appoint the county commission, the Sheriff and the State's Attorney to serve as the LEPC Board. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Maynard also provided an update on the multi-jurisdictional PDM plan, comprised of the

County and the Oglala Sioux Tribe.

2014 budget hearings were held with Auditor Sue Ganje, Treasurer Lori Bachand, Director of Equalization Susie Hayes and State's Attorney Jim Sword.

Eric Rounds, Butler Machinery, discussed options for road graders, including purchase of new or used machines and financing available. Motion by Kehn, seconded by Hutchison, to approve the purchase of a new motor grader and to surplus a 1985 130G grader and sell it by sealed bids on September 6, 2013. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried. An appraisal committee will be appointed.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Kehn, to approve the annual renewal for health insurance through Wellmark Blue Cross / Blue Shield. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Kehn, seconded by Diaz, to set September 6, 2013 at 12:45 PM as the time for a hearing on the distribution of fire insurance funds. With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried.

Motion by Hutchison, seconded by Diaz, to enter into Executive Session for personnel and legal matters, per SDCL 1-25-2(1) and 1-25-2(2). With no further discussion and all voting yes, the motion carried and the Board went into Executive Session at 2:27 PM.
