Hopkins noted that he did not receive his stipends in in July or August and requested a follow up on having 2 meetings each month.

Anna Takes the Shield (Dubray) joined the meeting via telephone at 1:20 p.m.

Lynx Bettelyoun, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board to provide updates. There was discussion regarding MSHA training, and on keeping first aid kits in County vehicles and equipment. Bettelyoun will talk with his administrative assistant to clarify that the CPR recommendation is 30 chest compressions and 2 breaths. It was recommended that employees should take CPR training every 2 years.

Motion made by Hopkins, seconded by Yellow Bull, to accept Bettelyoun's Monthly report.

Bettelyoun then requested to make changes to the Oglala Lakota County Policy Manual, addressing an annual leave payout if an employee is unable to use; transfer of sick leave hours to other employees, and payment of sick leave hours upon retirement. such as annual leave, Bettelyoun was requesting to have the sick leave hours being put back into the policy book, page 23.D.2.3. What if someone runs into trouble and they get sick, but they don't have enough hours to go to the hospital or to rest at home. Keep the required 120 hours to yourself. You can donate up to 22 hours /year.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Takes the Shield, to add to the policy the following: 1) Allow payment of annual leave if an employee is unable to use their full hours due to work emergency; 2) Allow donation of sick leave hours, up to 200.00 hours, to other employees, while retaining 120 hours for themselves; and Payout out Sick Leave up to 600 hours, upon retirement with letter from South Dakota Retirement Systems.

Bettelyoun then presented 2 Petitions for Private Road Maintenance.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Hopkins, to accept and approve the Petition for Private Road Maintenance from Felix Rodriquez, with payment in the amount of \$100.00.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Hopkins, to accept and approve the Petition for Private Road Maintenance from Ryan McDowell, with payment of \$70.00.

Discussion was held on 2 commission representatives to meet with the Land Committee to request reimbursement on maintenance costs for BIA Rd # 17, auditor to set this up. The board also asked a letter be sent to the FBI, the Oglala Sioux Tribe, the BIA and the Department of Justice to share costs with the County Coroner for supplies used in her job.

Daylon Black Bull, Sherriff, met with the Board to present his monthly report.

Motion made by Bear Runner, seconded by Takes the Shield, to approve Black Bull's monthly report.

Discussion was held on activities on a typical day, and Hopkins asked for a written report on milage to Oglala Lakota county and back to Box Elder when he is on duty. It was noted that PBT's were not admissible in court.

Black Bull reported that the MOU (allows for cross deputization between the county and the Oglala Sioux Tribal Chief of Police, Kevin Racher of the OST Police Department. Yellow Bull recommended Black Bull to meet with the State's Attorney, Lance Russell, to review the proposed MOU, Russell also has additional recommendations.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Takes the Shield, to continue working on the MOU between the county and the tribe.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Takes the Shield, to approve travel for Deputy Sheriff Derek Rojo to attend the 2025 Sheriff's Association Fall Training Conference in Watertown, September for the dates of September 30<sup>th</sup> – October 1st, 2025.

Sheriff Black Bull advised he passed the exam to move to a 5-day Reciprocity training in Pierre on 9-29 – 10-3, 2025 training rather than attending the full academy training.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Bear Runner, to approve Lexipol Master Service agreement between the county and Lexipol, with a 001 PoliceOne Annual Subscription of \$206.00 (\$103.00 per Officer), and P1A Account set up fee in the amount of \$355.00 Also, 002 Cordico Annual Subscription in the amount of \$999.00 for 2 Wellness Apps.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Bear Runner, to approve Deputy Rojo to work at the Black Hills Powwow association for the 37<sup>th</sup> annual He Sapa Wacipi in Rapid City on dates of October 10<sup>th</sup> @ 7:00 p.m., Saturday October 11<sup>th</sup> @1:00 p.m. and 7:00p.m., October 12<sup>th</sup> @ 1:00 p.m.

Teresa Pullen, Treasurer, met with the Board to request approval for payment plans.

Motion made by Hopkins, seconded by Yellow Bull, to accept a payment plan for Phinet Red Owl in the amount of \$400.00 per month for delinquent Real Estate Tax.

Motion made by Hopkins, seconded by Yellow Bull, to accept a payment plan for Leah and Dorthy Brown Bear in amount of \$200.00 per month for delinquent Real Estate Tax.

Commissioners discussed the payroll in September from Bi-weekly to Monthly, the Commissioners want to double check on whether they can do both Bi-weekly and monthly just to make it fair for both sides.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Hopkins, to change the payroll to Bi-weekly and monthly.

Motion made by Yellow Bull, seconded by Hopkins, to rescind motion and move it to the September 16, 2025, Special meeting at 1:00p.m.

Sue Ganje, County Auditor, met with the Board to review the annual budget and resolution for

taxes.

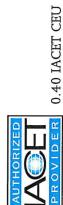

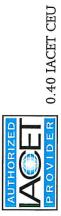

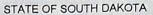

SUBJECT: Travel Reimbursement Rates for FY2026 – Effective October 1, 2025

DATE: September 23, 2025

As outlined in <u>HB 1060</u> during the 2024 Legislative Session, the mileage rate and the in-state lodging reimbursement rate will be updated to align with the rates set by the federal government.

### A. MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT

Effective October 1, 2025, the mileage reimbursement rate will increase to be consistent with the mileage reimbursement rate for business set by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), or \$0.70 per mile. If a state employee elects to use a personal vehicle for state business but an Office of Fleet and Travel Management pool vehicle is available, the mileage reimbursement rate will be set at 45% of the rate set by the IRS, or \$0.315 per mile.

### **B. IN-STATE LODGING**

Effective October 1, 2025, the maximum in-state lodging reimbursement rate will be consistent with the actual cost of in-state lodging, not to exceed the rate set by the <u>General Service Administration (GSA)</u>. The standard rate of \$110 per night will not change in FY2026 and will apply to travel in all counties in South Dakota, except for those specifically listed by the GSA. The lodging reimbursement rate for out-of-state and out-of-country travel will not change from the current rate of \$175 per night, with an additional \$100 available with excess lodging approval.
