Has anyone in your counties researched and confirmed there have been no new/updated fuel or chemical storage sites/facilities etc. built in Fall River/Oglala Lakota Counties since 2021?

Does Oglala Lakota County have an existing Hazmat Emergency Response Plan from before Fall River combined with them?

Should both counties be incorporated into one plan now that you have joined forces together?

There is a lot more territory to analyze and consider.

A full review and update of your existing Hazmat Emergency Response Plan is something you may want to consider applying for, \$7,500.00 is the typical amount the Planning Districts are charging for their services this past year.

Fall River's cost would be \$1,500.00 (Match) if the planning district charged you \$7,500.00 to update your plan.

I would be happy to convert your denied HMEP26 application for signage to a HMEP planning grant application (incorporating both counties) if you would like me to.
